FOREWORD



High level of consumer protection is one of the goals Bosnia and Herzegovina strives for on the way to EU accession. Some of the main objectives and tasks of Market Surveillance Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina are protection of the health and safety of consumers, informing the public and education. In order to ensure consumer protection in the segment of safety of non-food consumer products, several laws were adopted in Bosnia and Herzegovina, most important being the Law on General Product Safety and the Law on Market Surveillance in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

In accordance with the Law on General Product Safety, producers shall place only safe products on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Safe product means any product which, under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use including duration and, where applicable, putting into service, installation and maintenance requirements, does not pose any risk or only the minimum risk associated with the product's use, considered to be acceptable and consistent with a high level of protection of the safety and health of persons. However, continuous activities in the area of market surveillance of non-food products have shown that there are plenty of products on the market which are not compliant with the safety requirements and pose a risk to consumers' health.

Sometimes a safety risk posed by a product is determined only when the product is used. The most common risks that can occur are: electric shock, fire, injuries, choking, drowning, chemical risk, etc. In such cases, consumers may submit a complaint to Market Surveillance Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Customer complaints can be submitted in writing or electronically, using the form available on the website or at the premises of the Agency. In order to identify the product on the market as soon as possible, particular attention should be paid to accuracy of the product data entered in the form, such as description (photo of the product, if possible); name (e.g. brand, type, model, serial number, instruction manual); point of purchase (name and address of the point of sale, copy of the sales receipt); hazards/risks and the health effects associated with the product (e.g. electric shock, cuts, burns, allergies, etc.).

Please note that Market Surveillance Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina is not competent for consumer complaints related to consumers' economic interests, product warranties, product replacement, provision of services, product pricing, utility services, etc. In all of the above cases, consumers are referred to a competent institution.

PROACTIVE MARKET SURVEILLANCE IN 2018

In order to determine whether certain product groups placed on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina meet safety requirements from the regulations in force in Bosnia and Herzegovina, Market Surveillance Agency of Bosnia and Herzegovina in cooperation with the inspectorates of BiH entities and Brčko District of BiH conducted proactive surveillance of 23 groups of non-food consumer products in accordance with the Annual market surveillance plan for 2018.

BABY WALKERS



PURCHASING TIPS

When purchasing baby walkers, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

> Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

Products shall be labelled with the following markings/information:

- the name or trademark of either the manufacturer, importer or economic operator responsible for sale;
- number of the standard BAS EN 1273:2010 or EN 1273:2005;
- reference number or batch number;
- the inscription "WARNING: Never leave the child unattended";
 the warning can be used in conjunction with the pictogram.



Information for consumers at the point of sale shall be clearly visible and legible, and they shall include the following warnings:


- "Intended only for children who can sit unaided, approximately from 6 months.
 It is not intended for children who can walk unaided or weigh more than 12 kg".
- "WARNING: Never leave a child unattended".
- "WARNING: Prevent access to stairs, steps and uneven surfaces".

> Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

Instructions for use shall be supplied with each baby walker and written in one of the official languages in

BiH. The instructions shall include the following warnings and information:





- prevent access to stairs, steps and uneven surfaces;
- guard all fires, heating and cooking appliances;
- remove hot liquids, electrical flexes and other potential hazards from reach;
- prevent collisions with glass in doors, windows and furniture;
- do not use the baby walker if any components are broken or missing;
- this baby walker should be used only for a short period of time (less than 20 minutes);
- this baby walker is intended to be used by children who can sit unaided, approximately from 6 months; it is not intended for children weighing more than 12 kg;
- do not use replacement parts other than those approved by the manufacturer or distributor;
- instructions for regular maintenance and cleaning or washing.

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

When purchasing baby walkers, you may check the following:

- a baby walker shall be equipped with four wheels (if there are more than four wheels, the baby walker is considered to be unsafe);
- stoppers (brakes) shall be mounted on the underside of a baby walker;
- the height of the seat at its lowest position shall be at least 180 mm above the ground.

Baby walkers are intended to be used by children who can sit unaided, approximately from 6 months, with a maximum weight of 12 kg. A baby walker consists of a frame mounted on wheels, allowing the child to sit or stand up and move around.

PLAYPENS FOR DOMESTIC USE

PURCHASING TIPS

A playpen is an enclosure comprising barrier and integral base intended to retain a child whilst allowing it space in which to

play.

LEGAL BASIS

Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

Products shall be labelled with the following markings/information:

- number of the standard BAS EN 12227:2011 or EN 12227:2010;
- the name, trademark or other means of identification of either the manufacturer. distributor, importer or retailer;

When purchasing playpens, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

 any plastic covering used as packaging shall be marked with the following statement: "To avoid danger of suffocation remove plastic cover before using this article. This cover shall be destroyed or kept away from children and babies."

The following information shall be provided at the point of sale:

- the maximum age of the child for which the playpen is intended.

Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

In order to place playpens for domestic Bosnia and accordance with the Law on General Product Safety (Official Gazette of BiH, 102/09).

Instructions for use shall be supplied with each playpen and written in one of the official languages in BiH. The instructions shall include the following warnings and information:

 WARNING: "Do not place the playpen close to an open fire or other heat source";



- number of the standard BAS EN 12227:2011 or EN 12227:2010;
- registered trade name or trademark of the manufacturer, distributor, importer or retailer;
- means of identifying the product, e.g. model number;
- maximum age of child for which the playpen is intended;
- if the height of the base is adjustable, the base should always be used in the lowest position as soon as the child is old enough to sit, kneel or to pull itself up;
- an assembly drawing, list and description of all parts and tools required for assembly and a diagram of the bolts and other fastenings required (if applicable);
- statement drawing the attention of the user to the risk of leaving anything in the playpen which could provide a foothold or create a danger of suffocation or strangulation;
- statement that all assembly fittings should always be tightened properly;
- statement not to use the playpen if any part is broken, torn or missing and use only spare parts approved by the manufacturer;
- statement that accessories which are not approved by the manufacturer shall not be used;
- cleaning and maintenance recommendations.

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

When purchasing playpens, you may check the following:

- vertical distance between the upper surface of the playpen base at its lowest position and any part of the upper surface of the barrier shall be at least 600 mm;
- the openings in the mesh of a playpen shall be less than 7 mm wide;
- the edges of the playpen shall be rounded or chamfered.



CHAIRS FOR OUTDOOR USE



PURCHASING TIPS

When purchasing chairs for outdoor use, we advise consumers to pay attention to Chairs for outdoor use the following:

Is the product supplied with instructions for use?




Instructions for use shall be supplied with each chair for outdoor use and written in one of the official languages in BiH. The instructions shall include at least the following information:

- the following inscription shall be written at the top: "IMPORTANT, RETAIN FOR **FUTURE REFERENCE - READ** CAREFULLY" (in letters no less than 5 mm high);
- the name and address of the manufacturer/distributor/supplier;
- conditions for use of the product (camping, domestic or public use);
- instructions for maintenance (if applicable).
- Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

When purchasing chairs for outdoor use, you may check the following:

- the edges and corners of the chair that come into direct contact with the user during use shall be rounded and chamfered and shall not be sharp so as not to cause injuries to the user;
- accessible openings and gaps at the bottom of the chair legs and other open-ended tubes shall be less than 7 mm or more than 12 mm wide, with a depth of less than 10 mm.









can be used for domestic and public use, as well as for camping. Chairs for outdoor use shall be designed so as not to cause any injuries if used in accordance with the intended use.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place chairs for outdoor use on the market of Bosnia and shall be safe in accordance with the Law on General Product Safety (Official 102/09).



INLINE SKATES

PURCHASING TIPS

Inline skates are considered to be safe if they meet safety requirements specified in the standard BAS EN 13843:2012.

Inline skates have all the wheels arranged inline. They are divided into two classes:

class A: inline skates intended for users with a body mass of more than 20 class B: inline skates intended for users with a body mass of more than 20 kg and less than 60, and a length of the foot of no more than 260 mm.

When purchasing inline skates, we advise consumers to pay attention to the followina:




Products shall be labelled with the following markings/information:


- number of the standard BAS EN 13843 or EN 13613;
- the name, trademark or other means of identification of the manufacturer or retailer;
- means of identification of the model;
- maximum weight limit or indication of the class (A or B); if the maximum weight limit is not marked, this shall be given in the package.

Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

kg and less than 100 kg and Instructions for use and maintenance and other information about the inline skates shall be supplied with each pair of inline skates and written in one of the official languages BiH. in The instructions shall include the following information:







- information concerning limitations of use in accordance with the traffic safety regulations and recommendations regarding or descriptions of suitable surfaces (flat, clean, dry and where possible away from other road users);
- warning that the user should always wear protective equipment: hand/ wrist protection, knee protection, head protection and elbow protection;
- instruction to check that the steering mechanism, if present, is correctly adjusted and that the connective components are firmly secured;
- description of the correct techniques for use and for braking;
- instructions for maintenance and servicing, which should contain information on maintenance and lubrication of bearings, replacement of wheels, buffers and parts of the breaking device, steering adjustment and regular checks;
- inline skates' class.

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

When purchasing inline skates, you may check the following:

- all protruding components and edges on the inline skates that can come into contact with the user's body parts shall be rounded and smooth;
- binding elements shall be firmly attached in order to prevent unintentional disconnection;
- the wheels shall be constructed from non-slip material;
- the clearance between the starting and/or braking device and the ground shall be at least 7 mm, but not more than 17 mm.



LASER POINTER TOYS



PURCHASING TIPS

When purchasing laser pointer toys, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

> Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

Each laser product, depending on the class to which it belongs, shall be marked with the hazard warning symbol and the appropriate explanatory labels.

A laser pointer toy is a laser product with a power source (usually a battery) and a laser diode emitting a very narrow coherent low-powered laser beam of visible light. These are mostly toy guns with laser sights, swords, superhero toys and the like.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place laser pointer toys on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Law on General Product Safety (Official Gazette of BiH, 102/09).

Consumers are advised not to buy laser products higher than Class 2M, because they pose serious risk to consumers by causing damage to sight and eye injuries, and as such shall not be made available on the market.

> Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

Laser pointer toys shall be supplied with user instructions that contain all relevant safety information:

 adequate instructions for proper assembly, maintenance and safe use, including clear warnings concerning precautions to avoid possible exposure to hazardous laser radiation;



- for class 1M and 2M laser products an additional warning is required; this warning shall state that viewing the laser output with certain optical instruments (e.g. telescopes or binoculars) may pose an eye hazard and the user must not direct the laser beam towards the area where such instruments are used;
- legible reproductions of all required labels and hazard warnings to be affixed to the laser product or provided with the product, with the corresponding position of each label indicated.

Instructions for use shall be written in one of the official languages in BiH.



INFANT FEEDING BOTTLES

PURCHASING TIPS

Bisphenol A (BPA) is a synthetic organic compound with the chemical formula $C_{15}H_{16}O_2$.

According to the IUPAC² nomenclature, its name is 4-[2-(4-hydroxyphenyl) propan-2-yl]phenol. In the literature, its common name is 2,2-bis (4'-hydroxyphenyl) propane.

When purchasing infant¹ feeding bottles, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

- Avoid polycarbonate bottles (hard, glossy, transparent or coloured plastic, usually marked with the recycling code 7 or the letters PC at the bottom). The markings 7 or PC (which indicates polycarbonate) imply that the bottle is likely to contain BPA.
- Use bottles made of opaque plastic. These bottles (made of polyethylene or polypropylene) do not contain BPA. They are usually marked with the recycling codes 2 or 5. This type of plastic is considered to be the plastic with the least probability of releasing harmful substances.
- Glass bottles can be an alternative, but be aware of the risk of injury to you or your baby if the bottle is dropped or broken.



LEGAL BASIS

In order to place infant feeding bottles on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in terms of the content of bisphenol A in accordance with the Rulebook on plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food (Official Gazette of BiH. 66/17).

Markings for polymeric materials - numerals 2, 5 and 7:

- Since heat may cause the release of BPA from plastic, consider the following:
- Do not heat polycarbonate bottles in the microwave.



- Do not wash polycarbonate bottles in the dishwasher.

- Do not pour hot liquid into infant feeding bottles.
- Do not heat food or liquid in an infant feeding bottle; do it in a separate container.

ELECTRIC VACUUM CLEANERS



PURCHASING TIPS

When purchasing electric vacuum cleaners, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

> Is the product labelled with the required information?

Products shall be labelled at least with the following markings/information:

- manufacturer's brand name or trademark;
- model/type marking;
- conformity mark C or CE indicating that the product complies with all the regulations and standards applicable to it;
- rated voltage or rated voltage range in volts (V);
- rated power input in watts (W);
- symbol for nature of supply (~) or rated frequency (Hz);
- protection class marking.

> Is the product supplied with instructions for use?



Instructions for use shall be supplied with each product and written in one of the official languages in BiH. The instructions shall include all the details required for safe installation, use and maintenance.

The instructions shall include at least the substance of the following: CAUTION: This appliance contains electrical connections:

- do not use to suck up liquid (unless specifically stated otherwise);
- do not immerse in water for cleaning;
- the supply cord should be regularly checked for damage before use.

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

Safety requirements related to functionality and design shall be checked by visual control:

- Live parts of the appliance shall not be accessible. Also, there shall not be any live parts that are accessible when parts which can be removed without the aid of a tool have been removed.
- The connection between the supply cord and the plug, as well as the connection between the supply cord and the appliance shall be adequately designed, i.e. fixed by an "anchor".
- The appliance must be constructed so as to be protected against accumulation of dust on the engine or fan (dust bag or dust container).
- The appliance shall have adequate mechanical strength and stability in order to withstand foreseeable conditions of use.

An electric vacuum cleaner is a household appliance used for cleaning and maintaining household hygiene by collecting dust in a container that is intended for it. It is a common household product and it can pose risk of fire and electric shock to the user.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place vacuum cleaners on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Order on electrical equipment designed for use within certain voltage limits (Official Gazette of BiH, 98/09).





ELECTRIC WATER KETTLES

PURCHASING TIPS

An electric water kettle is a small household appliance used for heating water, which is then used for hot drinks. It is a common product in households and offices. Apart from risks of fire and electric shock, it can pose risk of burns to the user.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place electric water kettles

When purchasing electric water kettles, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

Is the product labelled with the required information?

Products shall be labelled at least with the following markings/information:

- manufacturer's brand name or trademark;
- model/type marking;
- and offices. Apart from conformity mark C or CE indicating that the product complies with all the risks of fire and electric regulations and standards applicable to it;
 - rated voltage or rated voltage range in volts (V);
 - rated power input in watts (W);
 - symbol for nature of supply (~) or rated frequency (Hz);
 - rated capacity in litres (L);
 - protection class marking.

> Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

Instructions for use shall be supplied with each product and written in one of the official languages in BiH. The instructions shall include at least the substance of the following:

- Unless a kettle is constructed so that a hazard cannot arise from boiling water or steam being ejected: Warning: boiling water or steam may be ejected!
- Sazette of BiH, 98/09).

 For kettles filled through a lid aperture situated below the handle: CAUTION: Position the lid so that steam is directed away from the handle!



- Warning: Do not remove the lid while the water is boiling!
- For cordless kettles: The appliance is only to be used with the stand provided.
- If the appliance and stand of cordless appliances can be lifted together by gripping the handle of the appliance: Ensure that the appliance is switched off before removing it from its stand.

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

Safety requirements related to functionality and design shall be checked by visual control:



- Live parts of the appliance shall not be accessible. Also, there shall not be any live parts that are accessible when parts which can be removed without the aid of a tool have been removed.
- Kettles shall be constructed so that the lid does not fall off when water is poured out (a screw-on lid or a lid which is permanently attached to the housing).
- The supply cord of the kettle shall not be longer than 75 cm, unless it is helically coiled.
- The appliance shall have adequate mechanical strength and

stability in order to withstand foreseeable conditions of use.

CORD EXTENSION SETS



PURCHASING TIPS

When purchasing cord extension sets for household use, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

➢ Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

Products shall be labelled at least with the following markings/information:

- manufacturer's brand name or trademark;
- model/type marking;
- conformity mark C or CE indicating that the product complies with all the regulations and standards applicable to it;
- cross-sectional area of the conductors in the mains cable;
- rated current in amperes (A);
- rated voltage in volts (V);
- rated maximum power input in watts (Wmax),
- symbol for nature of supply (~);
- protection class marking (if different than Class I).

Is the product supplied with instructions for use?



Common cord extension sets do not require instructions for use, since these are simple electrical appliances. Cord extension sets with special functions (e.g. stabilization of voltage, over-current protection and the like) requiring special instructions for use shall be supplied with the instructions. The instructions shall be supplied with each product and written in one of the official languages in BiH. The

instructions shall include all the details required for safe installation, use and maintenance.

A cord extension set for household use is used to connect electrical appliances to the mains where the direct connection is not possible. It consists of a cable of a certain length, fitted with a plug at one end and a single or multiple socket-outlet of the same design at the other end.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place cord extension sets for household use on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Order on electrical equipment designed for use within certain voltage limits (Official Gazette of BiH, 98/09).

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

Safety requirements related to functionality and design shall be checked by visual control:

- Earthing contacts of a plug and a socket-outlet shall be so designed that they cannot be easily deformed.
- Socket-outlets to be used in cord extension sets shall contain shutters protecting the holes in the sockets from insertion of small objects (other than plug pins) into the live connections.
- Live parts of the cord extension set must not be accessible.
- The connection between the supply cord and the plug, as well as the connection between the supply cord and the appliance shall be adequately designed, i.e. fixed by an "anchor".
- Cord extension sets shall have adequate mechanical strength in order to withstand foreseeable conditions of use.





ELECTRIC HAIRDRYERS

PURCHASING TIPS

A hairdryer is a common product owned by almost every household. It can pose risk of fire and electric shock to the user. The risk of electric shock is higher, due to the fact that hairdryers are often used in bathrooms.

When purchasing electric hairdryers, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

- manufacturer's brand name or trademark;
- type or model marking;
- conformity mark C or CE;
- rated voltage or rated voltage range (V);
- symbol for nature of supply (~) or frequency in hertz (Hz);
- rated power input in watts (W);
- protection class marking (if different than Class I);
- symbol indicating that a product is not suitable for use in a bath or shower.

Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

Instructions for use shall be supplied with each electric hairdryer and written in one of the official languages in BiH. The instructions shall include at least the following statements:

 A hairdryer can be used by children aged 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and

knowledge if they have been given supervision or instructions concerning safe use of the appliance and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.



- When the hairdryer is used in a bathroom, unplug it after use since the proximity of water presents a hazard even when the hairdryer is switched off.
- For additional protection, installation of a residual current device (RCD) having a rated residual operating current not exceeding 30 mA is advisable in the electrical circuit supplying the bathroom. Ask your installer for advice.
- The instructions shall include the following warning: Do not use a hairdryer near bathtubs, showers, basins or other vessels containing water.

> Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

Safety requirements related to functionality and design shall be checked by visual control:

- Plug pins shall be properly fixed, parallel and it must not be possible to distort them.
- The connection between the supply cord and the plug, as well as the connection between the supply cord and the hairdryer shall be adequately designed, i.e. fixed by an "anchor".
- There shall be no visible physical damages on the electric hairdryer.

COFFEE MACHINES FOR HOUSEHOLD USE



PURCHASING TIPS

When purchasing coffee machines, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

Products shall be labelled at least with the following markings/information:

- manufacturer's brand name or trademark;
- type or model marking;
- conformity mark C or CE;
- rated voltage or rated voltage range (V);
- symbol for nature of supply (~) or frequency in hertz (Hz);
- rated power input in watts (W);
- protection class marking (if different than Class I).

> Is the product supplied with instructions for use?



Instructions for use shall be supplied with each coffee machine and written in one of the official languages in BiH.

The instructions shall include a warning to avoid spillage on the connector, details on how to clean the surfaces in contact with food, a warning of potential injury from misuse and a warning that the heating element surface is subject to residual heat after use.

For coffee machines incorporating a pressurized reservoir filled by the user, the instructions shall contain information for safe refilling of the water reservoir and the following warning: "The filling aperture must not be opened during use!"

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

Safety requirements related to functionality and design shall be checked by visual control:

- The connection between the supply cord and the plug, as well as the connection between the supply cord and the coffee machine shall be adequately designed, i.e. fixed by an "anchor".
- Live parts of the appliance shall not be accessible.
- There shall be no visible physical damages on the coffee machine.

Coffee machines have been increasingly used in households. These products are most commonly used in kitchens, which additionally increases the risk of electric shock to the user in case the appliance comes into contact with water.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place coffee machines on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Order on electrical equipment designed for use within certain voltage limits (Official Gazette of BiH, 98/09).



ELECTRIC FANS

PURCHASING TIPS

An electric fan is a relatively common product. Although these products are relatively simple, if they are not manufactured in accordance with the relevant regulations, they can pose risk of electric shock and fire.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place electric

When purchasing electric fans, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

Each electric fan shall be labelled at least with the following markings/information:

- conformity mark C or CE;
- rated voltage or rated voltage range (V);
- symbol for nature of supply (~) or frequency in hertz (Hz);
- rated power input in watts (W);
- protection class marking (if different than Class I).
- > Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

Instructions for use shall be supplied with each electric fan and written in one of the official languages in BiH. The instructions shall include all the details required for safe installation, use and maintenance.

> Are there any visible defects o shortcomings related to product safety?

Safety requirements related to functionality and design shall be checked by visual control:

- The connection between the supply cord and the plug, as well as the connection between the supply cord and the electric fan shall be adequately designed, i.e. fixed by an "anchor".
- Live parts of the appliance shall not be accessible.
- There shall be no visible physical damages on the appliance.



HAND-HELD ELECTRIC CIRCULAR SAWS



PURCHASING TIPS

When purchasing hand-held electric circular saws, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

> Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

Each hand-held electric circular saw shall be legibly and indelibly marked at least with the following markings:

- conformity mark C or CE;
- name (or trademark) and full address of the manufacturer (or authorized representative);
- model, series or type reference;
- the year of manufacture and serial number, if any;
- rated voltage or rated voltage range in volts (V);
- symbol for nature of supply (~ or a.c.) or rated frequency (Hz);
- rated power input in watts (W) or rated current in amperes (A);
- symbol for class II construction (only for class II electric circular saws);
- IP number, according to degree of protection against ingress of water;
- rated no-load spindle speed;
- specific diameter or range of diameters of the blade;
- indication of direction of the spindle rotation.

> Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

Instructions for use shall be supplied with each product and written in one of the official languages in BiH.

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?



- Each hand-held electric circular saw shall be enclosed so as to enable adequate protection against accidental contact with live parts. Pulling, twisting or retraction of the supply cable shall not be possible.
- Each hand-held electric circular saw shall be provided with a blade guard to protect the user from accidental contact with the saw blade, ejected fragments of the material being cut, sparks and other debris.
- The blade guard may be adjusted and removed either with the aid of a tool or by performing two separate and dissimilar actions.
- Hand-held electric circular saw shall have appropriate gripping surfaces to enable firm grip during use.
- The accessible parts of a circular saw that can be touched during normal use shall not have sharp edges, ridges or points which could cause injuries.

MANDATORY WARNINGS:

WARNING: "To reduce the risk of injury, user must read the instruction manual".



The word "WARNING" shall be written in capital letters not less than 2.4 mm high and shall not be separated from the rest of the statement.

A hand-held electric circular saw is a tool powered by an electric motor and intended for cutting various materials with a rotating toothed blade in the form of a disc. In addition to careless handling, the most common injuries caused by hand-held electric circular saws may occur due to electric shock and mechanical injuries to hands, fingers, eyes and face.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place hand-held electric circular saws on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Order on the safety of machinery (Official Gazette of BiH, 04/10).

HAND-HELD ELECTRIC JIGSAWS

PURCHASING TIPS

A hand-held electric jigsaw is a tool powered by an electric motor and intended for cutting various materials.

The cutting action is achieved through a push-and-pull ("reciprocating") motion of the blade. A jigsaw is equipped with a blade roller guide, which allows you to adjust the blade rotation. Jigsaws are intended for cutting wood, plastic, metal, ceramic tiles and rubber. They are used for cutting straight lines and cutting at angles of up to 45 degrees.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place hand-held electric jigsaws on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Order on the safety of machinery (Official Gazette of BiH, 04/10).

When purchasing hand-held electric jigsaws, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

> Is the product labelled with the required markings/information?

Each hand-held electric jigsaw shall be legibly and indelibly marked at least with the following markings:

- conformity mark C or CE;
- name (or trademark) and full address of the manufacturer (or authorized representative);
- model, series or type reference;
- the year of manufacture;
- serial number, if any;
- rated voltage or rated voltage range in volts (V);
- symbol for nature of supply (~ or a.c.)
 or rated frequency (Hz);
- rated power input in watts (W) or rated current in amperes (A);
- symbol for class II construction (only for class II electric jigsaws);
- IP number, according to degree of protection against ingress of water.
- Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

Instructions for use shall be supplied with each product and written in one of the official languages in BiH.

> Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

 Each hand-held electric jigsaw shall be enclosed so as to enable adequate protection against accidental contact with live parts. Pulling, twisting or retraction of the supply cable shall not be possible.

- The blade guard may be adjusted and removed either with the aid of a tool or by performing two separate and dissimilar actions.
- Hand-held electric jigsaws shall have appropriate gripping surfaces to enable firm grip during use.
- The accessible parts of a jigsaw that can be touched during normal use shall not have sharp edges, ridges or points which could cause injuries.





 To restart the cutting-means rotation, two separate actions shall be performed. If these actions are performed with the same hand, the procedures shall be completely different (separate) to prevent accidental activation.

- All power-driven components, except the cutting means and groundcontracting parts, shall be guarded to prevent contact with these components during normal operation. The guards shall be fixed so that they can be opened or removed only with the aid of tools.
- The accessible parts of a lawnmower that can be touched during normal use shall not have sharp edges, ridges or points which could cause injuries.

A hand-held electric lawnmower is a grass cutting machine or a machine with a grasscutting attachment. The cutting device operates in a plane approximately parallel to the ground and uses the ground to determine the height of the cut by means of wheels or otherwise. It is powered by an electric motor. A pedestrian-controlled with or without traction drive, designed to be controlled by the operator walking behind the machine.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place hand-held electric lawnmowers on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Order on the safety of machinery (Official Gazette of BiH. 04/10).

BUOYANT AIDS FOR SWIMMING INSTRUCTION

PURCHASING TIPS

Buoyant aids designed to be worn fall within personal protective equipment intended to be worn, securely attached to the body and which have either inherent buoyancy or can be inflated. The most common risk for users of buoyant aids for swimming instruction is the risk of drowning.

LEGAL BASIS

Buoyant aids for swimming instruction

When purchasing buoyant aids for swimming instruction, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

> Is the product labelled with the required warnings?

The word "WARNING" (or "ATTENTION") shall be printed or debossed on the product in bold upper case, letter size not less than 5 mm in height. Colour may vary, but shall always be in contrast to the background and be legible. Next to or immediately below the word "WARNING", the following text shall be printed or debossed in lower or upper case and shall be not less than 3 mm in height:



- Will not protect against drowning.
- Always fully inflate all air chambers (if applicable to the product).
- Use only under constant supervision.
- To be worn on the upper arm only (for armbands).
- All components shall be worn (if applicable to the product).

The warnings can be replaced by corresponding graphic symbols.



The additional safety information symbol shall be used for armbands requiring that they be worn on the upper arm.

The additional safety information symbol shall be used for devices comprising more than one component requiring that a component not be omitted.




> Is the product labelled with the mandatory information?

In addition to the warnings and the accompanying text, a product shall be labelled with the following information: mass equivalent to size range and/or age range if appropriate; the number of the standard BAS EN 13138-1:2016 or EN

13138-1:2014; type designation of the product and commercial name, model or code; name or trademark of the manufacturer, importer or distributor.

Also, the label containing specific product information shall be attached to the packaging or displayed at the point of sale. The label may be attached to the product itself if the packaging is transparent. The size and class of the device shall be indicated by ticking " \checkmark " in the relevant box(es) of the label.



Is the product supplied with instructions for use?

Instructions for use shall be supplied with each product and written in one of the official languages in BiH.

Are there any visible defects or shortcomings related to product safety?

Inflatable buoyant aids shall have a minimum of two independent air chambers. Each chamber shall be fitted with a non-return valve. Stoppers shall be connected to the body of the valve.

WOOD-BASED PANELS FOR USE IN CONSTRUCTION



PURCHASING TIPS

When purchasing wood-based panels for use in construction, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

Is the product marked with the conformity marking?

Products shall be labelled with the conformity marking prescribed by the Rulebooks on labelling of construction products (Official Gazette of FBiH, 88/10 and Official Gazette of RS, 93/12) or by the standard BAS EN 13986+A1:2016 (on the territory of Republic of Srpska). The conformity marking includes the following information:

- "E" marking in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina and without marking or "CE" marking in Republic of Srpska;
- name and address of the manufacturer;
- the last two digits of the year in which the marking was affixed to the product;
- registered number of the authorized conformity assessment body or the laboratory authorized for testing (only if they participated in the conformity assessment procedure);
- number of the standard BAS EN 13986+A1:2016;
- name of the construction product;
- manufacturer's construction product identification mark;
- information on the characteristics of the construction product.

> Is the product accompanied by a Declaration of Conformity and Certificate of Conformity (for products under System 1?

Declaration of Conformity and Certificate of Conformity prove fitness for use of a construction product, and they are issued after conducting conformity assessment of the technical characteristics of a construction product with the technical specification. A Declaration of Conformity and Certificate of Conformity confirm that the product can be placed on the market and used for construction.

Wood-based panels for use in construction have wide and varied use. They can be used as structural and non-structural components in dry and humid conditions for both internal and external use.

The most common risk occurring in these products is failure to comply with the provisions proving fitness for use of a product.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place wood-based panels for use in construction on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Law on Construction Products in FBiH (Official Gazette of FBiH, 78/09) and by the Law on Construction Products in RS (Official Gazette of RS, 5/12).

Is the product accompanied by technical instructions?



Manufacturer, authorized representative or importer of the construction product shall issue technical instructions before placing the construction product on the market or in use. Technical instructions shall accompany each construction product placed on the market. All the information in the technical instructions shall be written in one of the official languages in BiH. Technical instructions shall include the information relevant for transport and use of the product. In addition to written information, technical instructions may contain schemes and illustrations for easier comprehension.



GYPSUM BINDERS AND GYPSUM PLASTERS

PURCHASING TIPS

Gypsum has been used in construction from the very beginnings of human civilization. Characteristic properties of gypsum are fast binding and hardening. The binding properties of all types of construction gypsum are the result of hydration process based on the ability of water rebinding and formation of dihydrate.

The most common risk occurring in these products is failure to comply with the provisions proving fitness for use of a product.

LEGAL BASIS

In order to place gypsum binders and gypsum plasters on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina, they shall be safe in accordance with the Law on Construction Products in FBiH (Official Gazette of FBiH, 78/09) and by the Law on Construction Products in RS (Official Gazette of RS, 5/12).

When purchasing gypsum binders and gypsum plasters, we advise consumers to pay attention to the following:

Is the product marked with the conformity marking?

Products shall be labelled with the conformity marking prescribed by the Rulebooks on labelling of construction products (Official Gazette of FBiH, 88/10 and Official Gazette of RS, 93/12) or by the standard BAS EN 13279-1:2010 (on the territory of Republic of Srpska). The conformity marking includes the following information:

- "E" marking in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina and without marking or "CE" marking in Republic of Srpska;
- name and address of the manufacturer;
- the last two digits of the year in which the marking was affixed to the product;
- number of the standard BAS EN 13279-1:2010;
- name of the construction product;
- manufacturer's construction product identification mark;
- information on the characteristics of the construction product.
- Is the product accompanied by a Declaration of Conformity?

Declaration of Conformity proves fitness for use of a construction product, and it is issued after conducting conformity assessment of the technical characteristics of a construction product with the technical specification. A Declaration of Conformity confirms that the product can be placed on the market and used for construction.

Is the product accompanied by technical instructions?

Technical instructions shall accompany each construction product and each single packaging placed on the market. All the information on the product/packaging and in the instructions shall be written in one of the official languages in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Technical instructions shall include the information relevant for transport and use of the product, and they shall

contain the expiration date or a notice that there is no expiration date. In addition to written information, technical instructions may contain schemes and illustrations for easier comprehension.



RESULTS OF PROACTIVE MARKET SURVEILLANCE IN 2018



During implementation of proactive market surveillance activities, 245 inspection controls were carried out and total of 214 various product models were controlled by administrative or visual control and/or laboratory testing (200 product models were tested in laboratories), out of which 118 product models (48%) did not comply with the prescribed safety requirements. As the result of these activities, 8,010 products were withdrawn from the market and recalled from consumers, out of which 6,553 products were destroyed. Economic operators removed the non-compliances in 7,888 products either voluntarily or at the request of the inspection authorities.

REACTIVE MARKET SURVEILLANCE IN 2018

The Agency initiated 45 cases of reactive surveillance in 2018. In 28 cases it was found that the products concerned were placed on the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

As the result of these activities, 10,345 products were withdrawn from the market and destroyed. 157 products were brought into compliance with the prescribed safety requirements.




SUMMARY RESULTS OF PROACTIVE AND REACTIVE SURVEILLANCE WITH MEASURES TAKEN

In 2018, total of 242 product models were controlled by administrative or visual control and/or laboratory testing, out of which 146 models (26,400 products) did not comply with the prescribed safety requirements.


Out of the total number of non-compliant products, economic operators removed the non-compliances in 8,045 products either voluntarily or compulsorily. 18,355 products were withdrawn from the market of Bosnia and Herzegovina and recalled from consumers, out of which 16,898 products were destroyed.

- Number of destroyed products




GROUPS OF PRODUCTS POSING SERIOUS RISK TO CONSUMERS
